FIRST IRT **PROFINET DEVICES** CERTIFIED

The first Certificates for PROFINET Conformance Class C devices covering Isochronous Real Time (IRT) functionality were awarded during the Hannover Fair in April. The devices are from Hilscher and Siemens. Testing was performed by ANF DATA of the Czech Republic, which is a PROFINET Competence Center and Test Lab.

ANF has also unveiled an IRT test module called SPIRTA,

which is an integrated plug-in module for the standardized PROFINET test system MoTest. SPIRTA will be used by all accredited PROFINET test laboratories in future for certifying PROFINET with IRT devices. ANF DATA or

BRAZILIAN BIOENERGY PROJECTS FOCUS ON PROFIBUS

As a result of the big expansion in bioenergy projects - sugar and ethanol production combined with electrical energy co-generation and the creation of new sugar cane plantations - PROFIBUS is playing a big role in the automation of three new industrial plants in central Brazil.

Smar was selected as the supplier for being able to offer a complete automation and control solution for mega-projects like these.

All three units started up in time for the new sugar crop, totally

in automatic control mode, prioritizing ethanol production first and soon after that, the production of VHP (very high polarity) sugar.

It is worth mentioning that to attain this degree of success, a detailed planning process was undertaken in each case, including Factory Acceptance Tests (FAT) and Site Acceptance Tests (SAT).

This company, located in the Edéia municipality (GO), is a joint venture between the Santelisa Vale Group, the Maeda Group - one of the largest Brazilian cotton producers - and British Petroleum. In addition to meeting production and productivity goals, attention was focused on maintaining high safety standards, which, according to industrial manager, Eng. Ana Cristina, were adopted in accordance with British Petroleum procedures.

The control architecture uses PROFIBUS PA, PROFIBUS DP and AS-i and includes 15 operator stations (with multiple monitors and redundant servers), an engineering station and a maintenance workstation. Process control data can be exported via the web. "In spite of the normal adjustments at startup, the decision to use PROFIBUS brought large benefits to the automation team as well as to the operators, due to the excellent cooperation between smar and the Tropical technical teams." said Ms. Ana Cristina Balan Oliveira Roque, Tropical Bioenergia industrial manager.

competence of the construction companies and the technical support of the Santelisa Vale corporate team.

Smar provided extensive support throughout the projects, from the specification and pre-definition of control loops to the design of control architectures and individual nets. For example, AS-i, PROFIBUS DP and PROFIBUS PA were used. The plants use a total of about 1,200 nets and more than 35,000 supervision points, across the three projects.

Now, Smar is considering the clients' needs regarding a second phase of investment and is already working on projects relating to the co-generation of electrical power.

Smar adds: "When bad news



JAPAN

Each year since 2006 the Japanese



PROFIBUS Organization (JPO) has held an event called 'PROFIBUS Day' and this year is no exception. 'PROFIBUS Day 2009' will take place in July in three cities - Tokyo, Osaka and Kita-kyushu, and JPO expects 210 people to attend. JPO will also show its multivendor demonstration systems covering PROFIBUS DP, PROFIBUS PA, PROFINET and AS-i.

CHINA



During March and April the China Association for Mechatronics Technology & Application (CAMETA) and PI combined to hold the 2009 'China PROFIBUS & PROFINET Expert Days' in Guangzhou, Kunming and Nanjing. Mrs. Wang Jun, the Secretary General of CAMETA, hosted the events and Mr. Jörg Freitag, the Chairman of PI, attended in person. Working Group leaders from PI also attended, along with domestic and external experts. Since the success of the 'PROFIBUS and PROFINET Expert Days' in 2008, this year's event received a great deal of attention. The event included not only wonderful

INDIA

The first one-day PROFIBUS Product Developer Training workshops took place in Pune, India on 13th and 14th March 2009. One workshop was conducted in the headquarters of Honeywell Automation for their development engineers and the second one was in Hotel Le Meridian for various aspiring PROFIBUS developers in India. Both events were organized by the UL Group based in Pune and presentations were given by Peter Fredehorst (Field Application Engineer), Lothar Schroettel (Sales

Director) from Profichip GmbH and Dileep Miskin who is head of the PROFIBUS centre at UL Group. Around 50 engineers in total were trained how to start a PROFIBUS Product Development. The main topics were the software and hardware structure of an integrated PROFIBUS interface, the differences between DP-V0, DP-V1 and DP-V2 protocols, PROFIBUS ASICs from Profichip, the RS485 physical interface design and PROFIBUS Tools. UL Group is setting up the first PI Competence Center in India.

PROFIBUS IN ASIA!

potential issues in the plant. After the basics had been covered, delegates also learned how important this can be to Life Cycle Management. They also appreciated the new PROFIBUS PA Profile 3.02, and E+H was able to demonstrate the automatic ident number adaptation with its new iTEMP TMT 84.

"In this way we created a lively learning atmosphere," says the company, "with theory in the mornings and encounters of the real kind in the afternoons."

NORTH AMERICA


